Possible fees mentioned are \$18.00 per week or \$275.00 per season for a 15'x15' area. The preference for products sold are farm grown and hand made products and no commercial merchandise. The months selected for Farmers Market are June 15 through October 15 and hours are between 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM. The plan for the Farmers Market will be in 2020. Chris has suggested possible additional funds we obtain could be used for scholarships in the agricultural area. The 4H club is considering having a booth at the Farmers Market
