

Lakeville Open Space Committee      April 8, 2010      7:30 p.m.

Members present: Brian Reynolds, Linda Grubb, Mike Schroeder, Don Foster, Joan Morton, Mike Renzi

Discussed problem getting maps done. SRPEDD has been trying since December to get Town parcel map and Assessor's data base needed for zoning and other required maps. Mike will send memo requesting Selectmen to expedite.

Noted that initial meeting of the Energy Conservation Subcommittee will be April 21. Don is our representative.

Minutes were read for February 11. Joan moved to accept. Don seconded. Vote unanimous. (No minutes for meeting posted for March 11 as there was no quorum. Linda and Mike Schroeder worked on Action Plan.)

Reviewed Sections 6 (Goals), 7 (needs assessment; noted that it is on website), 8 (goals and objectives), and 9 (action plan as table).

Discussed, as an aside, issues of seasonal versus year-round houses on ponds.

Reviewed night sky survey made by Mike Renzi and Ken Leonard. We will add this to Section 4. Noted that that faintest star visible was LMZ 6 and is now 5 (a decrease in visibility). We will add to Action Plan further protection of night sky, advocating enforcement of existing bylaw or improving bylaw to facilitate enforcement and make more effective, especially as concerns new residential construction or additions.

Reviewed in detail Action plan table, as revised by Mike Schroeder, in detail through Goal 1, Objective 1. Mike was emphatic that her revisions, based mostly on Section 4, need serious scrutiny by all Committee members and that Actions pertaining to other sections should be added by people who have worked on those sections. Noted that a representative from the Park Commission is sorely needed to make revisions pertaining to Recreation.

Noted that on May 25 6 to 8, Audubon will present "Shaping your Community", a follow up program to "Losing Ground".

Apparent violation of CR on Betty's Neck, which involved transporting material off property and inappropriate tree cutting, was discussed. We are not sure if it is still under investigation. Mentioned that Selectmen need to be prodded on issue of intended CR on Maxim property.

Don moved to adjourn at 9:20 p.m.; Joan seconded.
