Minutes read for Jan 6 and 14. Dan moved to accept with corrections. Brian seconded.

We will be getting a hard copy of OS plan to Joan so she can proofread.

We approved the wording of the credits and thanks to past and present contributors to the Open Space Plan

We decided to let Selectmen know we are short a member, that the Park Department is not represented and we would welcome someone from that department who comes with enthusiasm, but that they have not responded to our requests for a new OS Committee member or made comments on the revisions to the Plan. We discussed that it would be valuable to have a new member who knows the town.

We discussed the Action Plan and the idea that the Open Space Committee needs to be the instigator even when items will fall to other Departments to carry out. It was noted that some of the parties named as responsible in 2001 plan are actually resource agencies. A fourth column could be added to list such resource agencies.

When it is completed we will send the Action Plan to the Selectmen, and then when they have approved, it can go from them to the other boards.

Linda and Mike will work on a possible list of Actions.

Mike will add to Section 4 an update on the water tower completion scheduled for February 2011 and will add mention of cemeteries with a reference to the Appendix. Text will mention that Thompson Hill and Pond are the oldest and eligible for National Register.

Mail: Memo pertaining to open meeting law was circulated.

It was noted that Park Commission has announced the Ted Williams commissary will be closed until it is renovated.

Applications are due for the current grant round from the Taunton River Watershed Coalition.
