#### Q3 Are you registered to vote in Lakeville?







#### Q6 Do you have school aged children?



# Q7 If you have school aged children, are they enrolled in the Freetown/Lakeville school system?




# Q8 Do you have aging family members (65+) living with you at home?



# Q19 Are you interested in municipal curbside trash pickup? If so, how would you recommend paying for the curbside pickup?



# Q20 Should the town provide more support/incentives for new business opportunities even if they impose a cost for the town budget?


