Vigers proposal: Selectmen signed forest management bill. Noted that grant does not cover the last \$200. Forestry work would need to include enough timber to cover this. Phil Benjamin is not sure timber can be taken in ecologically sound manner. Selectmen also want wide trails to accommodate horses.
