Open space Plan is ready for delivery to the Board of Selectmen on November 8. Joan has only a few corrections. Plan will be dated 2011.

Horsley-Witten meeting was discussed and it was noted that it was good to observe a general conversation between Highway Dept., Building Dept., and Planning Board.

No action as yet on CR violation at Betty's Neck.

There may be another CR placed on the Town-owned Howland Property as mitigation for destruction of turtle habitat by the gravel removal at Ted Williams. Natural Heritage wants 20 acres but Rita has said the Selectmen will only agree on 10.

Harding Street project on Lakeville Nursery property has not yet gone through Conservation Commission as it has been continued several times at the applicant's request.

Mike Renzi is concerned about the outdoor lighting by-law. It was suggested that he write a new one and submit it to the Planning Board in time for next regular Town Meeting. It was noted that while OS could put it on the warrant it would be better if it came with the support of several boards. Mike will work on a by-law. It was also noted that there is more awareness about light pollution these days and that as this not a zoning by-law, a 2/3's vote would not be required.

Open space will resume its regular meeting schedule next month.
