

Lakeville Open Space Committee    October 14, 2010

Members absent by notice: Joan Morton, Brian Reynolds

Minutes read for August 12 and September 9. Don moved to accept with amendment to note that Daryl was not absent but had resigned. Linda seconded; minutes approved.

Open Space Plan: Action Plan is being consolidated and reduced in length.

Final maps are available for review. After discussion of which maps should be within text and which in section just before Appendices and what size maps should be, it was decided maps within the text will be 8 ½ by 11; maps before Appendices will be 11 by 17. Linda will email the maps to everyone.

We added to the list of things to discuss with Assessors that MassGIS does not show recent changes; e.g., LeBaron shows as one large single lot.

Linda reported that Ellie Baker had emailed to all members of the Lakeville Zoning Steering Committee (including Linda, Mike S., and Don of this committee) Horsley-Witten's proposed code reform document. Ellie asked for a meeting with the Selectmen but as of this meeting's date Nancy Yeatts (also on the Steering Committee) has not responded. Linda circulated hard copies of the document as two of OS members would not be able to access it on line. Horsley-Witten will make a public presentation of its Taunton River watershed projects at Ocean Spray Headquarters October 21. Projects to be presented include the driveway drainage improvements at the Ocean Spray plant in Middleboro, the Ted Williams septic system design, and the Lakeville Code Reform.

Linda attended the South Coast Rail meeting at which another round of technical assistance awards were made. Lakeville was awarded a study, to be done through SRPEDD, of regional transfer of development rights. Steve Olivier had been expected to attend the meeting also, but did not.

The Energy Committee is working on an energy-use monitoring plan and will be touring Old Colony which is in the last stages of its renovation contract.

Don moved to have Mike read the Sysco letter read at Planning board meeting read again at the upcoming Town Meeting. Linda seconded. Vote unanimous.
