On January 17, 2013, the Selectmen held a meeting at the Lakeville Senior Center to attend a presentation by MassDOT and SRPEDD regarding the Route 44 Middleborough Rotary Improvements. The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM. Present: Selectman Belliveau, Selectman Powderly, and Town Administrator Rita Garbitt. Also present: Superintendent of Streets Christopher Peck, Police Chief Frank Alvilhiera, Finance Committee Member Norman Orrall, Conservation Commissioner Emery Orrall, Conservation Agent/Planner Nancy Yeatts, Economic Development Committee Member Robert Chestnut, and Planning Board Member Sylvester Zienkiewicz. Cindy Dow from the Middleboro Gazette was recording the meeting and LCAM was videotaping.

Senior Project Manager Ryan McNeill from the MassDOT Highway Division gave a power point presentation on the possible alternatives for the Middleborough Rotary. Representatives from FST Engineers and Paul Mission from SRPEDD were also present. After reviewing the existing problems, project goals, the MassDOT Alternative, and the McMahon Alternative, the audience asked several questions. Once MassDOT receives comments back from the Towns of Middleborough and Lakeville, they will move forward with project development.

At 8:55 PM, upon a motion made by Selectman Powderly and with Vice-Chairman Belliveau stepping down to second and stepping back up to vote, the Board
