Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
September 16, 2013

On September 16, 2013, the Board of Selectmen attended the FEMA Flood Risk Review Meeting at the Lakeville Library. The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order at 1:35 PM. Members present: Selectman Belliveau, Selectman Powderly and Selectman Burke. Also present: Town Administrator Rita Garbitt. Matthew Ferreira from the Middleboro Gazette was recording the Meeting.

Gardner Bent, the Project Manager from the USGS (United States Geological Survey) gave an overview of the new Workmaps that have been distributed to the communities in Plymouth County. Mr. Bent stated that comments from the communities had to be returned in two (2) weeks.

At 1:55 PM, each of the Towns broke off into working groups to review their maps. The Selectmen moved their meeting into the History Room at the Library. Chairman Belliveau requested that the Workmaps be forwarded to the Building Department, the Planning Board, and the Board of Health for their review and comments. Since the Conservation Commission is not scheduled to meet until October 8, 2013, Ms. Garbitt will email the Members to let them know they can view the Workmaps in the Selectmen's Office.
